A MESSAGE FROM PAUL AND LINDA HOPKINS 2022/23 CAMPAIGN CHAIRS

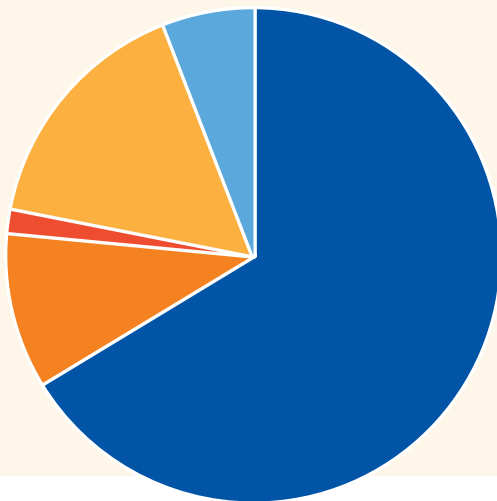
